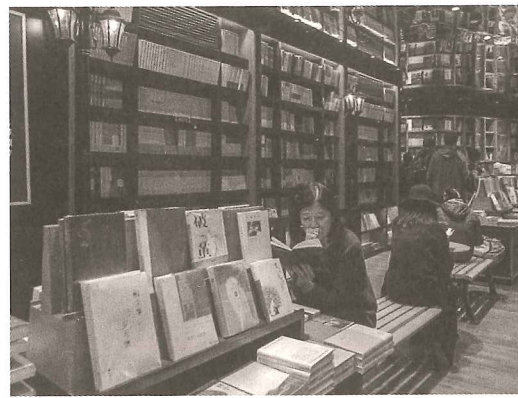
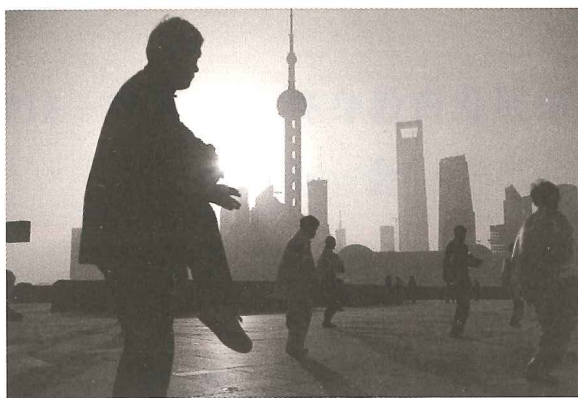
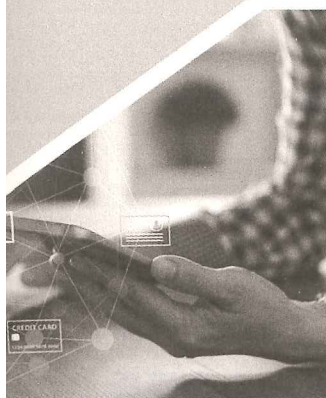

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《2015—2016 上海终身教育发展报告》

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前 言

2015—2016年间,上海终身教育迈入“合力共创、谋划未来”的重要发展阶段。本书力图反映上海终身教育该阶段取得的多方面成果。上海终身教育在该阶段,政策资源丰富、跨部门协作加强、市民学习的主体性更为凸显、终身教育的研究力量得到进一步聚合,并体现了对一些重大现实问题与制度建设如终身教育体系构建与体制机制建设、国家资历框架建设、学分银行发展、社区教育信息化发展等的理论关切。

从政策发展的成果来看,在圆满完成“十二五”期间上海终身教育发展任务的基础上,开启了未来三十年上海终身教育发展战略及“十三五”期间上海终身教育发展规划研制。2016年下半年,上海先后出台终身教育发展的三个重要文件,其中包括两个“十三五”规划(《上海终身教育十三五发展规划》《上海老年教育十三五发展规划》),一个进一步推进学习型城市建设的意见(《关于进一步推进本市学习型城市建设的若干意见》),它们为“十三五”期间城市终身教育的发展提供了路线图。此外,关于未来三十年上海终身教育发展的研究,发挥了民主党派参政议政的优势,融合了来自各级政府、实践部门及学界的众智,探索了未来城市终身教育的重要发展趋向。

从上海终身教育发展机制来看,这一阶段出现一个重要转折,即主要由政府教育行政部门推动,转向更多地整合其他部门的行政力量与资源协力推动,并更多地发挥市民作为参与主体的作用。2016年下半年由教育部门联合其他六个部门共同发布的《关于进一步推进本市学习型城市建设的若干意见》,体现了这一政策趋向。而黄浦区海派文化体验基地建设、闵行区市民读书节的推进等,均体现了不同部门间合力推进的成果。静安区的白领学习联盟在各部门的支持下,激发了白领们自主管理、自我发展的行为。这些新的变化与第二届国际学习型城市大会上发布的《墨西哥城宣言》所提出的相关战略发展方向具有一致性。

从上海终身教育研究力量来看,本书不仅反映了上海终身教育研究院专职科研人员的辛勤付出,更多体现了上海终身教育研究院学术委员会专家、特聘研究员、兼职研究员及青年研究员队伍的集体智慧。华东师范大学叶澜教授作为上海终身教育研究院学术委员会主

任,领衔完成了“终身教育视野下当代中国社会教育力的提升与聚通”,为本书提供了一篇很有分量的原创性研究报告。国家教育发展研究中心韩民副主任积极推动中日韩论坛的主办,并围绕终身教育体系建设开展比较研究,其成果对中国终身教育体系的完善富有启发性。这表明,在上海终身教育研究院这个平台上,上海乃至国内相关机构各路专家的专业支持与相互合作对上海终身教育政策与实践发展具有重要影响。

此外,上海终身教育的国际性视野也在本书中得到一定的体现,相关的国际与比较研究成果愈益深入。书中对2016年开启的中日韩终身教育论坛及其成果做了全面综述,就联合国教科文组织召开的第二届国际学习型城市大会要旨做了深入解读,就资历框架建设这一重大课题展开了比较研究等,意在借鉴国际先进经验,提升上海终身教育各方面的发展能级。

本书是继2013年首发《上海终身教育发展报告》之后,由上海终身教育研究院组织编撰的第三本反映上海终身教育理论研究与实践发展状况的报告。在上海市教育委员会终身教育处及上海终身教育界领导与同行的倾力支持下,在众多作者和上海终身教育研究院所有成员的共同努力下,本书终于面世了。上海各界终身教育工作者的创新实践,为本书所有研究成果提供了丰沛的素材。上海人民出版社领导及合作编辑的专业、敬业与默默的支持,使得本书顺利付梓。在此,谨代表编者对所有为本书付出智慧与汗水的朋友们表示由衷的感谢!

Preface

From 2015 to 2016, lifelong education in Shanghai entered an important development stage of “working together to create a future”. *Shanghai Development Report of Lifelong Education 2015—2016* strives to show achievements in various aspects of Shanghai lifelong education at this stage, such as rich policy resources, strengthened cross-departmental collaboration, more prominent subjectivity of citizens in learning and further aggregation of lifelong education research efforts. The report also reflects theoretical concerns on some major practical issues and institutional development like the construction of lifelong education system and institutional mechanism, the construction of national qualifications framework, the development of Shanghai Lifelong Learning Credit Bank and the development of community education informationization.

From the achievements of policy development, based on successfully fulfilling the task of Shanghai lifelong education development during the “12th Five-Year Plan” period, the development strategy for Shanghai lifelong education in the next 30 years and the formulation of Shanghai lifelong education development plan during the “13th Five-Year Plan” period were launched. In the second half of 2016, Shanghai issued three important documents for the development of lifelong education, including two for “13th Five-Year Plan” (*The 13th Five-Year Development Plan for Shanghai Lifelong Education* and *The 13th Five-Year Development Plan for Shanghai Senior Citizen Education*) and one for further promoting the construction of learning city (*Several Opinions on Further Promoting the Construction of Learning City in Shanghai*), which provide a road map for the development of urban lifelong education during the “13th Five-Year Plan” period. In addition, the research on the development of lifelong education in Shanghai in the next 30 years has made full use of democratic parties’ participation in politics, and has integrated the wisdom of all levels of govern-

ment, practice departments as well as academic circles, exploring the important development trend of urban lifelong education in the future.

From the development of lifelong education in Shanghai, an important turning point emerged at this stage. That is to say, it was transformed from mainly promoted by education administrative departments of the government to coordinately promoted by integrating administrative forces and resources of other departments, giving full play to the role of the public as a participant. In the second half of 2016, *Several Opinions on Further Promoting the Construction of Learning City in Shanghai*, which was jointly issued by education administrative department and other six departments, embodies this policy trend. The construction of the Experiential Learning Bases for Shanghai cultural acquisition in Huangpu District and the promotion of citizens' Reading Festival in Minhang District all demonstrate the fruits of joint efforts of different departments. The White Collar Learning Alliance in Jing'an District has stimulated the self-management and self-development of the young white-collar people with the support of many departments. Those new changes are consistent with the relevant strategic directions outlined in the *Mexico City Statement* issued at the 2nd International Learning City Conference.

From the research on lifelong education in Shanghai, this book not only reflects hard work of the full-time researchers of Shanghai Municipal Institute for Lifelong Education, but also presents the collective wisdom of the Academic Committee experts, distinguished researchers, part-time researchers and young researchers of the Institute. As the director of the Academic Committee of Shanghai Municipal Institute for Lifelong Education, Professor Ye Lan from East China Normal University completed *In Perspective of Lifelong Education: Integrating and Improving the Educational Strengths of Contemporary Chinese Society*, providing a valuable original research report for this book. Han Min, Deputy Director of National Center for Education Development Research, actively promoted the hosting of the China-Japan-Korea Forum and conducted a comparative study on building a lifelong education system. The findings are instructive for the improvement of China's lifelong education system. All in all, on the platform of Shanghai Municipal Institute for Lifelong Education, the professional support and mutual cooperation of experts from Shanghai and even relevant institutions in China have an important impact on the development of Shanghai's lifelong education policy and practice.

In addition, the international vision of lifelong education in Shanghai has also been shown in this book, and the relevant international and comparative research findings have become more and more in-depth. The book offers a comprehensive overview of the China-

Japan-Korea Lifelong Education Forum launched in 2016 and its achievements. It also makes an in-depth interpretation of the spirits of the 2nd International Conference on Learning City held by UNESCO. A comparative study is carried out on the qualification framework construction to draw on international advanced experience to better enhance the development level of all aspects of lifelong education in Shanghai.

This book is the third report compiled by Shanghai Municipal Institute for Lifelong Education reflecting the development of theory research and practice for Shanghai lifelong education after *Shanghai Lifelong Education Development Report* first published in 2013. Under the strong support of Lifelong Education Division of Shanghai Municipal Education Commission as well as leaders and peers in the city's lifelong education circle, the book has finally come out with the joint efforts of many authors and researchers of the Institute. The innovative practice of lifelong educators in Shanghai provides a wealth of material for all the research findings in this book.
